This year, Onion TV - partnering with World Rugby - will bring its globally acclaimed rugby format 'The Season' to St. Joseph's College Ipswich, where it will follow four teams in the lead-up and during the tournament itself, as each school strives for the prestigious National title.

Under St Joseph's College Ipswich's Director of Sport Anthony O'Riordan, the Festival has attracted some of rugby's biggest schoolboy stars: Chris Robshaw, Mako Vinupola, Jonathan Joseph, Christian Wade, Jamie Roberts, Matt Dawson, Mike Tindall, Andy Goode, James Haskell, Tony Diprose, Lewis Ludlam and Tom Rees are just some of the players who have stamped their mark on the Festival before going on to international fame.

The tournament has grown in stature - possible only by the hard work and tenacity of the host school - and as

the Festival edges nearer, four teams go under 'The Season' spotlight as the countdown to immortality begins. School memories will be forged under the fire of competition, but the National Schools Festival cares not for tradition nor reputation. Instead, the prize is awarded for surviving the war of attrition under the most competitive of circumstances.

THE SHOW

'THE SEASON' is an Onion TV concept produced in partnership with some of the world's leading high schools that shines a spotlight on their sports programs and holistic culture through a combination of unique inside access and cinematic storytelling.

Launched in 2016, the series has become one of the most watched and critically acclaimed grassroots sports documentary online and on broadcast television. It has also been nominated for numerous sports media awards including Sportel's Golden Podium, Australia's Sports Media Awards, Astra Awards and ATOM Awards.

'The Season' embeds itself within a high school sports program for the duration of their respective season, in an effort to experience first hand how student-athletes handle the pressures of sport, work and life.

As the cameras roll, the narrative reveals itself as each team navigates the fine line between the perilous pitfalls of defeat and expectation, while weathering the intoxicating heights of victory and success. There is tradition to uphold, a title to be defended, a legacy

of anecdotal tales from former students, all peppered with the knowledge that sport can be a cruel leveler as it pays little reverence to the effort and emotion that each team expends in order to hoist the trophy high in victory.

Teams must dig deeper than ever before to find the resolve, motivation and desire to repeat as champions, avoid relegation or claim a first ever premiership. The key content revolves around the human interest stories - of students looking to juggle academia, faith and culture with the lure of sporting glory and of a school charged with the responsibility of guiding the boys or girls on the path to their future endeavors.

Onion utilises high-end cinematography with use of **CREATIVE** slow motion coverage married with the imperative 'inside access' live mic capture. The audience experience is fully immersive, lending a visual arc to **SIGNATURE** the human interest narrative. Onion TV has a unique production model that adopts a low maintenance presence with experienced operators who practice an invisibility mindset that leads to engaging 'behind the scenes' access while being silent witnesses to the action and interaction before them.
