SERIES 1 - LIFE WITH THE NSW WARATAHS

The Code takes viewers inside Australia's oldest provincial rugby team in pursuit of the 2011 Super Rugby title. Share the personal journey of players, coaches, administrators and fans as they experience the highs and lows that victories, losses and injuries bring. Gain privileged access to the extended Waratah family including fans, sponsors and volunteers, witness life on tour in New Zealand and South Africa and marvel at the physical and mental demands of professional rugby in the mounting crescendo towards Super Rugby glory.

8 x 30 minutes

SERIES 2 - LIFE WITH THE QUEENSLAND REDS

The reigning champion Queensland Reds have come from the depths of financial ruin to winners of the Super Rugby title in only three years. The cameras follow the team through the 2012 season, taking time to look at the club's darker times, its rise from the ashes and its present day challenges. While the fairytale accomplishments of the previous season are celebrated and analysed, the demands of professional sport leaves no team untouched as the Reds continue to grow and expand their off field brand while the plabecome on field targets for the rest of the competition.

5 x 30 minutes

SERIES 3 - LIFE WITH THE ADELAIDE THUNDERBIRDS

The Code cameras join the Adelaide Thunderbirds netball team during the eight days leading up to their traditional clash with arch-rivals, the Queensland Firebirds. Witness the squad undergo an intense week of recovery, self-analysis and preparation, cullminating in their clash against the reigning title holders of the ANZ Championship. The audience gets a backstage pass to an 'all-access' experience with players, coaches and administrators of the Adelaide Thunderbirds, with no punches pulled or holds barred to reveal a side of elite female sport never before seen.

3 x 30 minutes

SERIES 4 - LIFE WITH THE CENTRAL COAST MARINERS

The Central Coast Mariners are a small team that punches above its weight in a big sporting market. The smallest club in the Asian Champions League, the Mariners defy the odds to be one of football's greatest over achievers in Australia's A-League and the biggest club competition in the Southern Hemisphere. Following Graham Arnold's men from pre-season through to post-season, this series has a front row seat to a year that started with great promise, and fulfils into its own expectations as the side marches towards its first Championship title.

11 x 30 minutes

SERIES 5 - LIFE WITH THE ADELAIDE THUNDERBIRDS

The Code cameras return to Adelaide as the 2013 Thunderbirds begin their journey from the physical demands of pre-season camp through to the pressure cooker atmosphere of the ANZ Championship Grand Final. Filmed during select periods of the 2013 season, the Thunderbirds organisation again granted exclusive access to allow the coaching team and playing group to execute their success plan on film as part of this four-episode series. Viewers are granted front row seats during the pre-season camp in South Australia, the Summer Challenge in Melbourne, the team's final regular season game, and the build up to the ANZ Championship decider as the Thunderbirds look to win their second title. The Code captures the trials and tribulations of elite netball in its unique cinematic style.

4 x 30 minutes

SERIES 6 - LIFE WITH THE BRUMBIES

In this sixth instalment of the Astra Award-nominated series, the Code cameras go deep inside the Brumbies organisation as the planning for the 2016 season begins. The Code spends two months with the team as they navigate their way through the intensity of preseason preparation in Canberra, a three day training camp in Jindabyne, through to their warm-up fixture against the Waratahs in Wagga Wagga. Join one of professional rugby's most successful teams, as internationals, veterans and rookies all embark on a journey to secure the Super Rugby trophy.

4 x 30 minutes

SERIES 7 - LIFE WITH THE PREMIER 12

The Premier 12 is an international baseball tournament that brings together the top 12 teams in the WBSC World Rankings over a two week period in to determine the inaugural championship winner and a \$1 million first prize. Attracting some of the world's best baseball players in the colours of their home countries, the Code goes behind the scenes of this global event, accessing areas previously unseen by baseball fans and the television audience as the Premier 12 travels through Taiwan and Japan on the way to the Grand Final.
